Key Vocabulary

English

Our English topic links directly to our art unit as we will be learning all about Andy Warhol as we will be writing a biography. Within this unit we will be learning the following:

- Fronted adverbials and sentences openers
- Chronology
- Relative clause
- Direct quotes and facts

Our biographies will accompany our art work when we host an Andy Warhol inspired art exhibition.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will be learning about: Multiplication and Division and Length and Perimeter.

Within the Multiplication and Division unit we will be applying our previous knowledge and understanding of multiplication facts as we learn to multiply and divide by 10 and 100. We will then look at strategies to multiply and divide 2- and 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers using informal and written methods. This will allow students to apply their understanding of multiplication within increasingly challenging questions.

Within Length and Perimeter, we will look at equivalent lengths (kilometres and metres) and look to measure the perimeters of different shapes.

Science

Science this term will see students preparing their investigation for the VAT Science Fair. This year has a focus on engineering. Students will create an investigation following the scientific enquiry approaches and skills. We will be applying our knowledge and understanding of materials: solids, liquids and gases.

Computing

In Computing this term, we will be learning about thinking online, considering the reliability of what we read and access online, and consider how we do this whilst staying safe.

Religious Education

Within Religious Education we will be looking at Islam and How important is the Prophet Muhammed to Muslims?

P.E.

In P.E students will learn about a variety of swimming skills. Eventually we will learn to do breaststroke, front crawl and backstroke.

Spanish

This term, we will learn about family members and faces. We will learn to name different family members and then write some information about them. We will also learn to name parts of the face and write a face description.

Geography

Within our Geography topic, Earthquakes and Volcanoes, we will be exploring the structure of the earth and how this relates to the cause and distribution of earthquakes and volcanoes. We will introduce the 'Pacific Ring of Fire' and consider why people choose to live in these zones.

Art

Our Art unit this term will focus on the work of Andy Warhol within the pop art movement. We will learn about and the techniques and uses of colour Warhol used and apply these to create some of our own Warhol inspired pieces that reflect our current popular culture.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be exploring the themes of identity, society and equality: Democracy. We will learn about Britain as a democratic society, looking at how laws are made and the importance of following these. Then, explore the role of local council and the services provided.

Music

Our learning within Music will focus on developing our violin skills and reading notation

Learning to Learn

Our learning to learn focus this term will be noticing. Beginning with the book 'Noticing' by Kobi Yamada' which provides an opportunity to explore the skills of noticing.
